Christy Road Trail Extension - Summary

Thanks for your consideration of this proposed trail extension. Below is additional information to help clarify the project.

The project is defined as: <u>Extending a 7' trail from the west entrance of Overlook Lane to</u> <u>Southern Hills Drive with one rest stop</u>. This will be roughly 12,825 ft2 of new trail area connecting the existing trail to Southern Hills Drive. (*see attached map*)

Work is scheduled to be completed in October, 2020.

Based on City of Sioux City's prior trail projects and square footage the total cost is estimated around \$145k.

Project Donors/Contributors: Woodbury County: \$15k (requested) Siouxland Trails Foundation: \$10k (committed) Sioux City Cyclist: \$1k (committed) Scheels: \$3,100 (committed) Dairy Queen: \$5,000 (committed) Southdale Nursery: \$2,500 (committed) City of Sioux City: \$40k (estimated ancillary costs)

Overlook Developers LLC will be responsible for the remaining costs to complete the project.

Counties funds will not be contributed until the project is completed.

SCOPE OF WORK:

Trail Work:

Survey and layout the trail, remove vegetation/topsoil, compact top 6" and trim sub-grade. Paving to include 6" of DOT C4 mix, 7' wide with a target of 1.5% cross slope (not to exceed 2%). Trail to be approximately 4' off of the back of curb and 3" above curb. There will be three sets of ADA panels for road crossings.

Landscaping:

Trail will be back filled, graded and all disturbed areas will be seeded with MidAmerican Fescue. Disturbed areas will be watered and maintain till grass established.

Rest Stop Area:

Rest Stop Area consists of a concrete slab, bike repair station, bike rack, bench, and landscaping.

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
