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IMPROVEMENT REQUEST

Department/Division Title: Emergency Services, Gary Brown, Director

Request: Increase the ¼ Part-time Paramedic position by 150 hours.

<u>Justification</u>: This request is to increase the number of budgeted hours of the ¼ Part-time Paramedic by 150 hours at the Paramedic rate of \$18.90 per hour, going from 520 hours to a total of 670 hours.

The 520 hours; this is based on a 40-hour work week. The three Full-time Paramedics are scheduled for 2,760 hours annually, 690 hours is a guarter of that schedule.

There are three Full-time Paramedics, all have been with the department over a year. Each Full-time Paramedic earns 80 hours of vacation leave and 96 hours of sick leave each year. The total amount of vacation leave (240 hours) and sick leave (288 hours) combined is 528 hours annually.

The increase of 150 hours is justified as it moves the budget closer to the actual number of ¼ part-time hours needed at a minimum to cover leave time accrued by full-time staff.

<u>Financial Impact</u>: The financial impact would be \$5,020.06, that is the combination of \$2,835.00 for Wage Plan Emp. Part Time, \$968.72 for FICA (Medicare & Social Security and \$1,216.91 for IPERS. (Totals for each budget line item is shown below.)
