DGR Agreement

The board approved paying the DGR Agreement establishing a 28E between Woodbury County & the City of Sioux City from the CIP Fund. After conferring with Jason Comisky, our CIP Legal Attorney, it has been determined that this expenditure does not qualify as a CIP Project.

After reviewing gaming revenues, there is unallocated revenues in FY20 in the amount of \$134,648. This amount is inclusive of no gaming revenues from the Hard Rock through June, 2020. During FY21 budget hearings I anticipated a carryover of \$175,000 in addition to gaming revenues for FY21. For FY21, there was budgeted \$254,623 unallocated. This amount is reduced by the loss of gaming revenues in FY20, which now leaves \$214,271.

It is recommended that the \$15,000 is paid from gaming revenues which will reduce the FY21 unallocated funds in the amount of \$199,271.
